

Tia Oros Peters is a mother, grandmother, wife, and aunty; writer and artist. A community organizer and movement builder for over three decades, she serves as CEO of the Seventh Generation Fund for Indigenous Peoples which supports cultural revitalization, empowerment, self-determination, and Re-Indigenization strategies. A recognized expert in Indigenous Peoples' rights, Tia coined the term Aquacide from her international advocacy and frontline work protecting Indigenous Peoples' distinct relationship to Water. Co-founder and convener of the Global Indigenous Women's Caucus, Indigenous Women Worldwide, and the Red Deer Center, she currently serves on the boards of directors of the Proteus Fund, and Tools & Tiaras, and is a member of the national Advisory Committee of Grantmakers for Girls of Color.
